Occupation Description

Provide barbering services, such as cutting, trimming, shampooing, and styling hair, trimming beards, or giving shaves.

Nature of Work

Barbers cut, trim, shampoo, and style hair mostly for male clients. They also may fit hairpieces and offer scalp treatments and facial shaving. In many States, barbers are licensed to color, bleach, and highlight hair, and to offer permanent-wave services. Barbers also may provide skin care and nail treatments.

Distinguishing Characteristics of Levels

Note: Examples of Work are intended to be cumulative for each progressively higher level of work. The omission of specific statements does not preclude management from assigning other duties which are reasonably within the scope of the duties.

Basic

Employees in this Role assist in performing standardized barbering services.

Recommended Education and Experience for Full Performance

High school diploma or GED, and must be at least 17 years of age and have graduated from a State-licensed barber or cosmetology school.

Minimum Qualifications

Tenth grade education and must be at least 17 years of age and have graduated from a state-licensed barber of cosmetology school.

Operational

- Employees in this Role Independently provide barbering services, which include cutting hair, giving shampoos, scalp treatments, etc.
- Employees maintain the barbershop and work station, and ensure the principles of sanitation, personal hygiene, and grooming methods are implemented.

BARBERS

Recommended Education and Experience for Full Performance*

High school diploma or GED, and must be at least 17 years of age and have graduated from a State-licensed barber or cosmetology school and six (6) months paid experience as a barber.

Minimum Qualifications

High school diploma or GED, and must be at least 17 years of age and have graduated from a State-licensed barber or cosmetology school and three (3) months paid experience as a barber.

Advanced

- Employees in this Role provide specialized barbering services.
- Employees prepare purchase orders for supplies and equipment needed for the barbershop.

Recommended Education and Experience for Full Performance

High school diploma or GED, and must be at least 17 years of age and have graduated from a State-licensed barber or cosmetology school and one (1) year paid experience as a Barber.

Minimum Qualifications

High school diploma or GED, and must be at least 17 years of age and have graduated from a State-licensed barber or cosmetology school and six (6) months paid experience as a Barber.

Knowledge and Skills

Knowledge

Customer and Personal Service — Knowledge of principles and processes for providing customer and personal services. This includes customer needs assessment, meeting quality standards for services, and evaluation of customer satisfaction.

Skills

Active Listening — Giving full attention to what other people are saying, taking time to understand the points being made, asking questions as appropriate, and not interrupting at inappropriate times.

Speaking — Talking to others to convey information effectively.

Monitoring — Monitoring/Assessing performance of yourself, other individuals, or organizations to make improvements or take corrective action.

Social Perceptiveness — Being aware of others' reactions and understanding why they react as they do.

Service Orientation — Actively looking for ways to help people.
