

FY23-24 SoNM Summer Internship FAQ's

1. My agency is interested in hosting a summer intern. How do I request an internship position?

An Intern Create Request Form must be completed by the interested mentor and agency human resource department.

- 2. Is the summer internship a temporary position?
 - Summer internship positions will be temporary (T-180 positions). The creation of positions must be approved by the State Personnel Office and Department of Finance and Administration. 1.7.3.9 (A) NMAC
- **3.** Who provides funding for the agency summer internship positions? *The funding for an internship position will be provided by the host agency.*
- 4. When requesting the summer internship position, is the agency required to choose an intern type on the Intern Create Request Form upon submission to SPO?

Yes. The intern classification, intern type, <u>must be selected</u> from the drop-down menu on the Internship Create Request Form. Mentor must identify which intern level(s) they wish to hire:

- High School Intern, Job Code: SGHI87 (Pay Band 35)
- College Undergraduate Intern, Job Code: SGCI17 (Pay Band 55)
- Graduate School Intern, Job Code: SGGI20 (Pay Band 60)
- 5. Will agencies determine the length of the summer internship or are all internships required to be the same length of time?

The agency will determine the length of the internship. Summer internships can vary in length from six-ten weeks depending on the needs of the agency We recommend an internship length of ten weeks long to allow interns to attend the internship summit in early August 2024.

6. What is the deadline for submitting intern create requests? Agencies are required to submit the Intern Create Request Form by Tuesday, November 15, 2022 to: workforce.planning@spo.nm.gov

7. Will my agency HR create and post the internship position my agency requested?

The State Personnel Office will create and post internship positions. All internship position will be advertised on the SoNM career website on January 15^{th} .

8. What is the length of time the internship positions will be advertised?

Internship positions will be advertised as 60-day continuous postings. The SPO Recruitment Team will coordinate with DoIT to designate the internship as a "hot job." A "hot job" ensures the job posting will show at the top of the job posting list.

9. When will the internship positions close?

All advertised Internship positions will close on March 15th.

10. Who is responsible for screening internship applications?

Your agency HR will screen intern applicants and provide an applicant list to the assigned mentor.



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
